

Warming Shelter Rules:

The shelter is not your house, but you are a welcome guest. A guest is someone who is invited to stay for a temporary length of time. **We reserve the right to withdraw from any guest, at any time, the invitation to stay in our shelter.** If you do not feel comfortable here, or if you feel you cannot abide by our shelter rules, you may want to consider finding other accommodations. ***You are a guest, not a client, or renter. Everyone must follow the rules or you will no longer be a welcomed guest.***

Operating Procedures:

Hours of Operation: Warming Shelter hours are from 7:00pm to 7:00am

Non-Violence: All guests will treat each other with mutual respect. All disputes will be handled, in a peaceful manner. Those who do not settle disputes in a peaceful manner will be asked to leave. Threat of **violence will result in immediate eviction.** Physical horseplay is not tolerated in the warming shelter.

Weapons: Firearms or weapons are not allowed on the premises at any time **EVER!**

Theft: Theft in the shelter, or anywhere else, will result in immediate eviction and a lifetime ban from the shelter.

Meals: Limited food products and donations are provided.

Shelter Hours: All guests must leave the shelter between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. **DAILY** Guests will clean-up after themselves every morning before leaving the warming shelter. Guests are to leave everything in good order to help facilitate the proper functioning off other programs.

Please make your stay here a pleasant one.

We ask that you show respect to all guests, volunteers, and employees.
